Florida Medicaid is amending the Long-term Care Managed Care Waiver and will be submitting a draft transition plan for how we will implement the new Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services' Home and Community Based Settings rule.

The new rule makes sure that waiver recipients get their services from providers who:

- Work with them to create a plan of care;
- Make them feel at home if they live in a group home, assisted living facility, or adult family care home; and
- Help them be part of the community.
